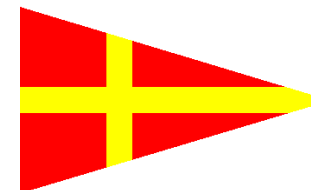

OUR HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY, EMERGENCY RESPONSE PROCEDURE & CHILD WELFARE POLICY ARE ALL DISPLAYED IN THE CLUBHOUSE

Members are advised **NEVER to sail alone**
Junior members must have parental or appointed guardian supervision

Personal buoyancy must be worn when afloat.

Children are only allowed on the jetties, when wearing Buoyancy Aids.

Wetsuits or Dry suits are essential in the winter.

All boats must be insured, and have adequate regularly checked buoyancy

GENERAL INFORMATION

Lease limitations on our site

Members may sail **ANY day** from 1st April - 31st October but

ONLY Sundays outside of this period.

A maximum of 10 boats are allowed on Eels Foot Broad from the 1st July - 31st October

No boat painting or major boat repairs on site.

No engines except those on our Safety Boats

Fishing & Swimming are NOT permitted

Dogs are banned from the clubhouse but are allowed on site provided they are kept on a lead.

Burgh Wood Road has a 10mph speed limit
