SOLO HELP SHEET

- The Green decked Solo is in berth 190 with a dark blue cover
- The Blue decked Solo is in berth 191 with a lighter blue cover
- There are four Solo sails in the boat-shed. 2 are in better condition and are intended for racing use only
- The rudders and tillers are stored in the boats

Before launching

- Check all the bungs are in and inspection hatches closed
- Ensure self-bailers are closed
- Secure any items likely to be lost during a capsize
- Check trolley tyres are inflated to ease manoeuvring
- Only hoist sail when head to wind and lower it when not sailing

<u>After use</u>

- Please sponge or hose the boat clean
- Remove bungs and raise bow to drain water out
- Check buoyancy chambers are drained as necessary
- Please try to dry wet sails, but without letting them flap
- Roll sail onto its tube, aligning battens with tube and into its bag. Return sail to boat-shed

• Re-fit cover and secure tightly to prevent ponding of rainwater, using the halyard to raise the middle of the cover on Green Solo
