

RACING NOTES

OOD/Safety Boat duties are organised on a rota basis, all full members are expected to perform two duties per year.

Competitors must sign in before going afloat, **as this confirms insurance**. Trolleys should not be left blocking the slipways, driveways or other people's berths.

The programme is based on all-comers. There are six series during the year. The Eels Foot Series runs through the Spring, Whit, Summer and Autumn. Wednesday Evenings Pursuit Series during Spring and Summer months.

Only members are eligible for Club Series trophies. Series prizes will be awarded if a minimum of 3 races have been sailed.

Visitors are welcome (up to 5 times a year) - they are covered by our insurance - provided their host member has signed for them in the visitors' book.

Rules for control of Invasive Species are strictly enforced. All visiting boats and launching trolleys must be thoroughly cleaned before launching and when leaving the site.

SATURDAY SESSIONS

During the months of May, June & July we aim to have an experienced club sailor present on Saturday afternoons

(from approx 1pm to 4pm) to give help & advice if needed, or to be holding organised activities suitable for all levels of sailors.

OUR HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY, EMERGENCY RESPONSE PROCEDURE & CHILD WELFARE POLICY ARE ALL DISPLAYED IN THE CLUBHOUSE

Members are advised **NEVER to sail alone.**
Junior members must have parental or appointed guardian supervision.

Personal buoyancy must be worn when afloat.
Children **must** wear buoyancy aids on the jetties.

Wetsuits or Drysuits are essential in winter.
All boats must be insured, and have adequate regularly checked buoyancy.

Safety boat helms must remember to use the Kill Cord when operating the engine.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Members may sail **ANY day** from 1st April - 31st Oct but **ONLY on Sundays** outside of this period.
A maximum of 10 cruising boats are allowed on Eels Foot Broad from the 1st July - 31st October.

No boat painting or major boat repairs on site.
No engines except those on our Safety Boats.
Fishing & Swimming are NOT permitted.
Dogs are allowed on site provided they are kept on a lead. Dogs are **not allowed** in the clubhouse or to go afloat at any time.
